

## **Turf Fields & Lights Frequently Asked Questions**

**The fields are pre-lined for soccer, lacrosse and field hockey. Are other sports able to be played on the fields?**

To be considered a playable field, the field can only have four different colors. For short-term rental usage, lines can be drawn with turf-appropriate, temporary paint products.

**What equipment is provided in the rental and what needs to be provided by my team?**

Norfolk Collegiate will provide the surface and access to our goals, as well as parking, bleacher seating and use of our scoreboards. Cones, pinneys, balls and other field equipment are not provided.

**What are the bathroom facilities like?**

Norfolk Collegiate does not provide access to our building or locker rooms. Portable restrooms will be set up for the duration of the event.

**Are the fields available during school hours or are they only available after school and on weekends?**

The fields are only available during after-school hours and on the weekends, at this point in time.

**Are there certain times that the facilities are unavailable for rental?**

The fall and spring evenings are booked very quickly. Norfolk Collegiate rents the athletic complex on a first-come, first-served basis.

**How much parking can be accommodated with the schools' parking lots?**

More than 300 parking spots are available at Norfolk Collegiate. Additional on-street parking is also available.

**Do I have to rent both fields at one time or can I rent only one or half of one or a quarter of one?**

Norfolk Collegiate rents the fields together or separately, but we do not rent portions of the field.

**Do clubs, etc. have access to Norfolk Collegiate's locker rooms when renting the turf field?**

No

**Is there a space that they can utilize for post game parties?**

Organizations may utilize the school's parking lot and green space for post or pre-event celebrations.

**Is there a concessions option available?**

At the current time there are not concession options.

**Can the fields be used for things other than sporting events, such as fairs, etc.?**

Yes, but only upon agreement with Norfolk Collegiate and as long as the event needs will not damage the synthetic turf.
